




































POLES AND ROSES I







POLES AND ROSES II

Inspired by the wings of the mythical bird, the Phoenix, the pattern is impactful in its small scale. The range features 12 colour ways.












































LONGCHAMP




CONFETTI


This is a celebratory, light-hearted and fun design that has movement to it that is inspired by joyful confetti at parties.

































LADYBIRD
